Development objectives include maintaining macro-economic stability, accelerating economic growth and improving living standards (through, inter alia, completing privatisation process, attracting higher level of foreign direct investments and development of small and medium sized enterprises)

The challenge in front of the country now is how to reconcile the twin objectives of sustainable development preserving the ecological and social resources of the country and rapid economic growth that is based on the use of space and other environmental resources.

National Strategy for Sustainable Development was prepared in 2005-2006

SEA – EIA laws prepared and adopted 2005 (implementation started in January 2008)

National Council on Sustainable Development (existing since 2002) was expanded to ensure wider stakeholder representation

November 2006, former Ministry of Environmental Protection and Physical Planning was split and merged with the Ministry of Tourism (environment and communal affairs sectors) and the Ministry of Economy (physical planning sectors)

Environmental Protection Agency established

Co-ordination between different levels of government is unsatisfactory.

The potential with which business sector can contribute to effective environmental management is largely under-utilised in Montenegro.
